

Terms and Conditions

These conditions define the basis on which RCVS Knowledge offers support. RCVS Knowledge seeks to establish a partnership with bursary holders in which each party is clear as to its rights and obligations. Accepting a bursary from RCVS Knowledge implies the understanding and acceptance of the following terms and conditions.

Bursary Holder Obligations

1. The bursary holder is assumed to be the person named on the application form.
2. To be eligible for the bursary, the bursary holder must fall under one of the following categories at the time of VET19 (27th – 28th June 2019):
 - i. veterinary student
 - ii. veterinary nurse
 - iii. practice manager
 - iv. returning to practice
 - v. information specialist
 - vi. veterinary surgeons in their first five years of practice
3. Successful applicants will receive an access-all-areas ticket to VET19. RCVS Knowledge will also cover reasonable travel and subsistence expenses up to a maximum of £150, on the provision of relevant receipts.
4. The bursary holder must attend VET19 (27th – 28th June 2019). If the bursary holder is unable to attend, notification **must** be sent in writing to ebvm@rcvsknowledge.org as soon as possible so that the bursary can be offered to another applicant. RCVS Knowledge will not reimburse any expenses unless the bursary holder has attended the event.

Finances

5. The bursary is provided for the approved application. Only travel and subsistence costs relating to the event can be claimed, on the provision of receipts.

RCVS Knowledge Obligations

6. The bursaries are administered by RCVS Knowledge, under the general guidance of the RCVS Knowledge Grants Panel and Board of Trustees.

7. RCVS Knowledge will publicise details of the award and the names of bursary holders on our website, and in other relevant publications.

Withdrawal of a Bursary

8. RCVS Knowledge reserves the right at any time and without notice to withdraw a bursary, either in full or in part, if the bursary holder fails to comply with these terms and conditions. This includes failure to take up the bursary within 28 days of the offer.

Modification of variation of regulations

9. RCVS Knowledge reserves the right to modify, add to, or vary these regulations as it sees fit, and undertakes to give prior notice to the bursary holder of any change.
10. RCVS Knowledge will seek to ensure that the bursary holder is not disadvantaged by such changes.
